twin bear cabernet sauvignon

Aromas of bramble berries, vanilla and a hint of black pepper give way to flavorful black cherry, fresh plum, currant and a hint of crushed stone. Showing polished tannins that are at once restrained and balanced, this is a wine of refined elegance and grace, immensely enjoyable now but with the structure to grow even more lovely in the years to come.

Twin Bear is a Walla Walla Valley Cab from a region that built its reputation on red wines, Cabernet Sauvignon in particular. Grapes for this inaugural vintage were predominately selected from Heather Hill Vineyard, located along the southwestern reaches of the Walla Walla Valley AVA. Its soil, aspect and growing conditions provide expressive grapes of exceptional quality.

Handpicked grapes were de-stemmed, carefully sorted to ensure optimal berry selection, and fermented in stainless steel tanks. Regular punchdowns during fermentation helped achieve full extraction. Aged 29 months in IOO% new French Taransaud oak barrels to soften the wine and fully integrate the flavors.
