rosé | v. 2025

Inspired by the celebrated rosés of Southern France, the 2025 Blushing Bear Rosé is a vibrant blend of Grenache and Mourvèdre, drawn from the sunlit vineyards of the Walla Walla Valley. Its pale salmon hue offers a first impression of elegance and finesse. Aromas of wild strawberry, white nectarine, and rose petal are lifted by a bright note of citrus peel. The palate unfolds with layers of watermelon, Rainier cherry, and ripe raspberry, accented by a subtle hint of crushed herbs. Crisp acidity brings lift and definition, carrying the wine to a clean, polished finish.

Sourced from select Walla Walla Valley vineyards, the grapes were hand-harvested and gently whole-cluster pressed to preserve delicate aromatics and clarity of flavor. Fermented and aged exclusively in stainless steel, the wine retains vivid fruit expression, bright acidity, and lifted aromatics, resulting in a rosé defined by vibrancy, precision, and purity.
