

TWIN BEAR

Cabernet Sauvignon | v. 2019



Our 2019 Twin Bear Cab displays bright acidity and the elegant, dark fruit character that defines Walla Walla Valley Cabernet Sauvignon. It is beautifully aromatic, with generous notes of black cherry, baking spice and a hint of vanilla bean. Layers of flavorful cassis, wild blackberries, and currants mingle with earthy undertones across a textured, refined palate and a lengthy finish. Savor now or cellar for added enjoyment for years to come.

Grapes for the third release of Twin Bear Cabernet Sauvignon were selected from Heather Hill Vineyard, located along the southwestern reaches of the Walla Walla Valley AVA. Its soil, aspect, and growing conditions provide expressive grapes of exceptional quality.

Handpicked grapes were de-stemmed, carefully sorted to ensure optimal berry selection, and fermented in stainless steel tanks. Regular punch-downs during fermentation helped achieve full extraction. Aged 34 months in new Taransaud French oak barrels.
